Foster Industrial Park, an addition to the City of Bristow, according to the recorded plat thereof, Thence N 89° 50' 40" W a distance of 24.75 feet to a point on the West line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31 along the South line of the Arthur M. Foster Industrial Park, Thence N 00° 00' 00" E along the West line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31 a distance of 456.30 feet to the Northwest corner of the Arthur M. Foster Industrial Park, Thence S 89° 50' 40" E a distance of 968.00 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 2, Block 1, of the Arthur M. Foster Industrial Park, Thence N 00° 00' 00" E parallel to the West line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31 a distance of 208.00 feet to the North line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31 said point also being the Northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 1, of the Arthur M. Foster Industrial Park, Thence N 89° 50' 40" W along the North line of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 31 a distance of 968.00 feet to the point of beginning.
