The regularly scheduled meeting of the Bristow City Council was called to order in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 7:00 P.M. A roll call was had with the following members present. Mayor Leon Pinson. Councilmember: Bob Edwards, Frank Groom, Darold Ritchie, Tex Slyman, Leon Smith, Deloris Carter, and Leonard Washington. Absent: Councilman Al Johns.

At this time Teddy Abbott an attorney for Mr. Dunham, Dunham Asphalt, objected to the approval of the minutes after the Mayor had read agenda item#1, which was asking for the approval of the Minutes written on June 7, 2010. Mayor asked Mr. Abbott if he was objecting to the Minutes. Mr. Abbott asked if these were the minutes that referred to the Special Meeting on last Thursday. Mayor replied "No". Mr. Abbott apologized for the interruption.

Motion was made by Groom with a second by Smith approving Minutes of the June 7, 2010 Meeting. A roll call was had with the following members present voting as follows: Edwards, Aye; Groom, Aye; Ritchie, Aye; Slyman, Aye; Smith, Aye; Carter, Aye and Washington, Aye. Motion passed.

Mayor said to make note that he objected to the approval of the Minutes. Mr. Abbot asked if he could speak about the special meeting that was on last Thursday. Mayor told him that he could not do to it not being on the agenda. At this time Mr. Abbott stated that there would be a lawsuit filed against the city.
